3 NOW, THEREFORE,

4 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE, THE**
5 **MAYOR CONCURRING, THAT:**

6 Section 1. The City Council supports the creation of 25 new Patrol Officer positions in
7 the Seattle Police Department and asks the Executive to brief the Council, by July 1, 2005 on the
8 goals, measures, and planned evaluation of the deployment of these officers, within the context
9 of their current level of police officers, to best address the public safety priorities of Seattle
10 residents and businesses, in a comprehensive and strategic approach.

11 Section 2. The City Council requests a 2006 Executive budget submittal that includes a
12 plan to fund those law enforcement functions that support collaboration and information sharing
13 with citizens and other relevant agencies. Elements of this plan may include a presentation of
14 the current crime level and public safety priorities of Seattle residents and businesses for each
15 precinct. To address these problems, the plan may include the restoration of the Crime
16 Prevention Coordinators, Community Service Officers, and funding for School Resources
17 Officers for each precinct; the focus of this plan should be on those functions that enhance
18 information sharing about public safety issues between the Seattle Police Department, citizens,
19 and relevant agencies.

20 Section 3. The Council intends to begin discussion of a potential November 2005
21 property tax levy to fund law enforcement and emergency human services by creating
22 partnerships between precinct police teams and targeted human service priorities and funding
