Dear Postmaster,

At the December 1999 meeting of the Miller Park Neighborhood Association, my neighbors and I were discussing traffic-related issues in our neighborhood.

One issue that came up was the problem of vehicles driving the wrong way down a one way street in our neighborhood: the two blocks of 21st Ave. E. between E. Republican Street and E. John Street, which are one-way going South. These blocks are immediately adjacent to Meany Middle School and the Miller Playfield, so we are especially concerned that the traffic laws are obeyed and hence that our kids are kept safe.

One neighbor reported having seen a Post Office delivery truck going the wrong way on that street. Other vehicles do so as well, but your vehicles are easily identifiable and should (we feel) set a good example.

**Please remind your drivers in our neighborhood of the importance of obeying all the traffic laws, and remind them of the one-way nature of 21st Ave. E. near Meany Middle School.**
